5. Applicant may attach copies of awards and honors. Not to exceed a total of 20 pages,
6. Applications should be enclosed in a clear plastic or three ring folder or binder.
7. Applications will not be returned to applicants regardless of the outcome of the selection process.
8. **DEADLINE:** Applications are due to the local lodge by **FEBRUARY 1ST 2008**. No late applications will be accepted. Remember BE PREPARED.
9. If additional space is needed please attach on a separate piece of paper.
10. Submit at least two letters of recommendation with application from persons in the following areas school, community, church or scouting.
11. Submit a copy of Eagle Scout certificate.
